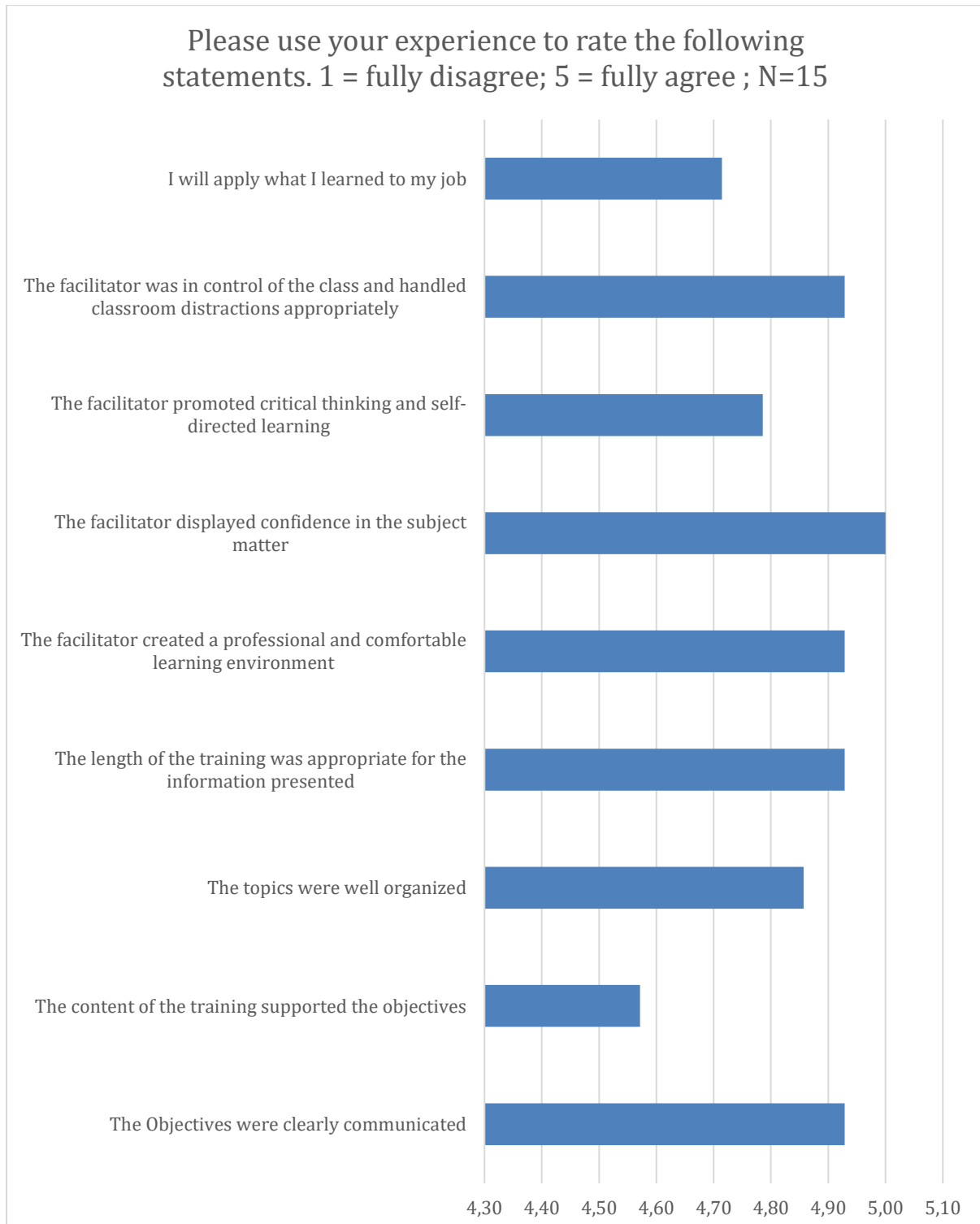








Participants Feedback





What topics would you have liked to have spent more time on?

- National legislative
- Dual education at HE level
