## 2. Meeting with Working Group

Professor Bojan Melovic informed the participants about the meetings of working group. Professor Savic explained the main features of the pilot study programs.

## 3. Generic Model of Dual Education

After short discussion, the consensus was reached about generic model of dual education in HE of Montenegro. The next step is activity 2.2 Organization of Conference on DUALMON added value to industrial sector.

## 4. Development of Plan for dissemination and exploitation of project results

Professor Ilija Moric presented the draft version of the plan. Professor Savic informed the participants that D&E plan is necessary for submission of Interim report and it will be modified during the project lifetime. Statistics about dissemination activities must be collected (the number of dissemination events, number of informed stakeholders etc.). The recommendation from Djuro Stojanovic (Uhura Solutions) is to collect statistics through Similar Web or Google Analytics.

## 5. Internal dissemination at University of Montenegro

Internal dissemination must be constant, with 2-3 news about the project every month.

## 6. Presentation of Uhura Solutions d.o.o.

Mr Djuro Stojanovic (Uhura Solutions) presented his company to LC meeting, as a new project partner.

## 7. Metrics for the project and pilot study programs

Collection of statistical data about pilot study programs is of great importance for the reporting to EACEA in Brussels. The file with necessary data must be delivered before the middle of the project, for the Interim report, in July 2022.

## 8. Meeting in Serbia, February 2021

The proposed dates of the visit to Novi Sad are 7-11.2.2022. If situation allows, the consortium will consider the visit to Vienna instead of Novi Sad.
